SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

Friday August 17th.

7pm. – OPEN Blind Draw Tourney. Everyone welcome. \$20/person.

Signup between 4pm-6:30pm.

Format: Race to 21, best 2 out of 3 in winner's bracket AND losers bracket.

8pm-12am Live Entertainment

Saturday August 18th.

9am – "B" Division Doubles Tourney. \$60/Team.

Everyone welcome, *with the exception of*, Nationally Recognized "Pro Level" players. This determination will be made by the tournament committee.

Format: Pool Play to determine brackets. Top half will go to upper bracket, bottom half will go to lower bracket

At this point, the players from the "B" Division can enter the "C" or the "A" tourney if they wish. Sign up for the next 2 tourneys will commence immediately after the "B" tourney finishes.

Approximately 2pm – "A" and "C" tourneys to start.

"A" Tourney entry fee of \$80 and "C" Tourney entry fee of \$40

"A" Tourney Format: Best 2 out of 3 in the winners, and 1 and done in the losers.

"C" Tourney Format: Best 2 out of 3 in winners and losers bracket.

Sunday, August 19th

9am- OPEN Singles tourney. \$40/person.

"A" Division Player: A player that plays a lot of tournaments and wins occasionally. They average about 3 bags in the hole each round and can play with anyone in the country on any given day.

"B" Division Player: A player that plays a handful of tourneys each year and is competitive when he/she plays. This player can occasionally compete with the "A" player, but often times will get beat by them.

"C" Division Player: A player that plays a tournament or two each year and has fun doing it. This player can compete with a "B" player on occasion, but would rather have fun and drink some beer! This is your typical backyard player/campground player.
